In 2009, we emitted 41,000 tonnes of CO₂
from energy consumption

The operations in Denmark account for 75%

From 2008 to 2009, we reduced energy
consumption in Denmark ↓ 10%



Goal of reducing CO₂ emissions from air travel from 2008 to 2010 ↓ 15%



From 2008 to 2009, we reduced CO₂ emissions from air travel by ↓ 35 %

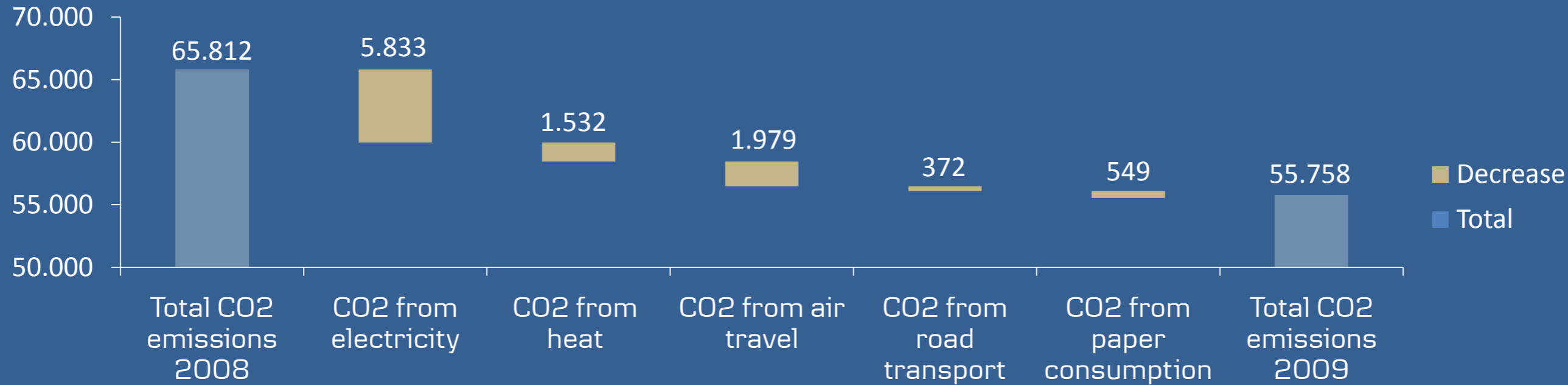
In 2009, we have saved ↓ 698 tonnes of CO₂ by using TelePresence meeting technology



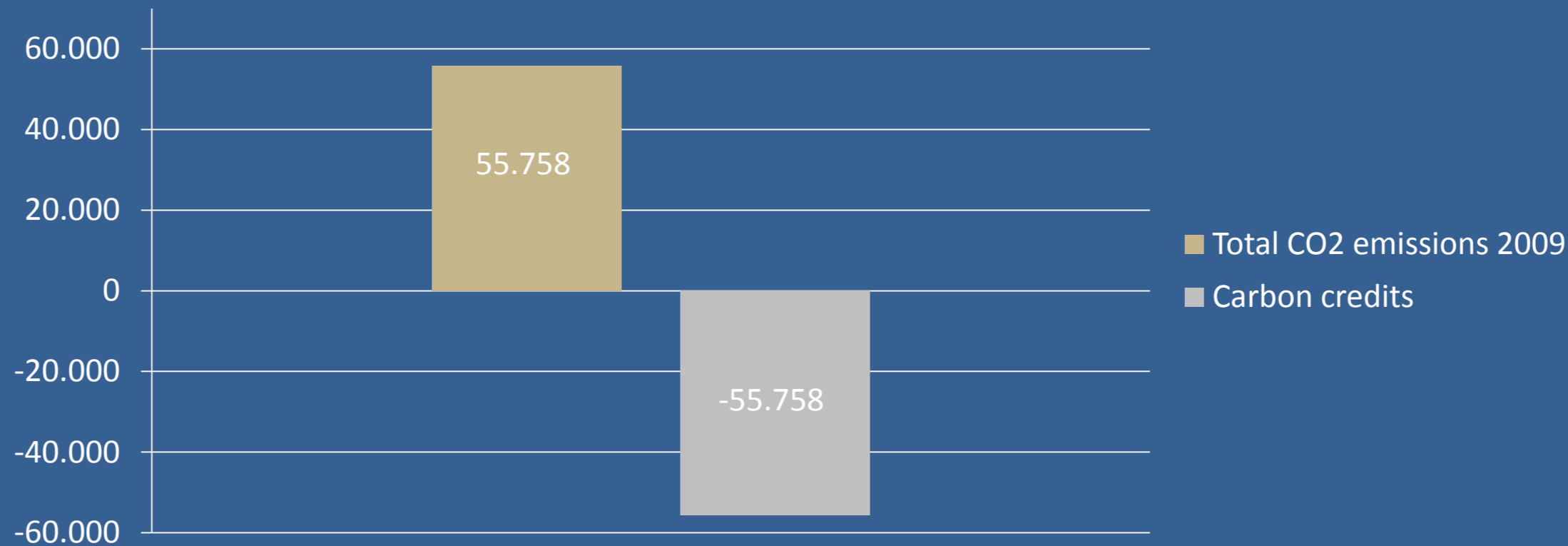
From 2008 to 2009, the Group reduced paper consumption by ↓ 18%

In the past year, more than 1.7 million customers have received more than 32 million documents via the Internet

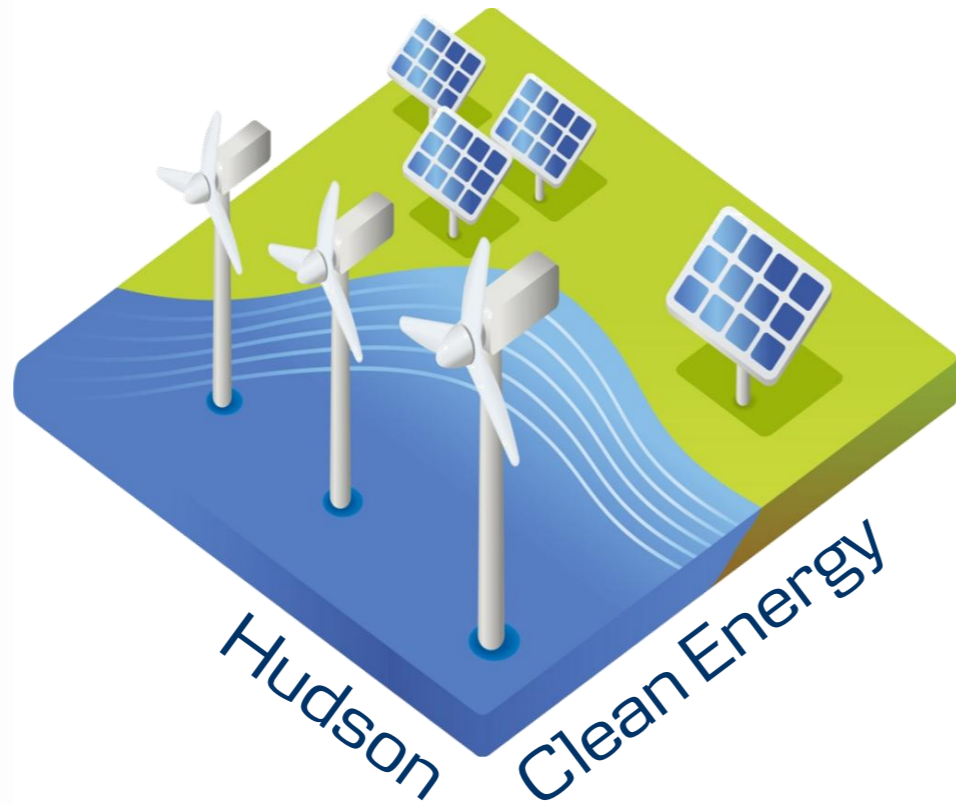
CO₂ emissions from Group activities (tonnes)
